Alhamdulillah, our High School Qur'an classes, are held twice a week for all Year 7 to 10 students. One period is dedicated to completing a Khatm ul Qur'aan (recitation of the entire Quran). As the students recite, our emphasis is on Makhaarij al Huroof and Tajweed. For students who are advanced readers, we do revision of the Tajweed rules throughout the year and introduce them to our novice readers. The students who are still at the initial stages of their journey with the Quran, are given a one-on-one time to assist with the makhaarij and tajweed so that they too become confident readers. Maa shaa Allah, the majority of our students are proficient Quran readers, and have done very well throughout the year Alhamdulillah.
