STUDENT PLACEMENT POLICY FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS AND STAFF

PURPOSE

To ensure effective and fair student placement into class lists.

SCOPE

This policy applies to students from Years KK to Year 12 and specifies a protocol for student placement and transfer of students from classes based on a fair and efficient system coordinated by the Assistant Principal – Pastoral Care.

POLICY

Policy for Staff:

- Staff may request placement of their child / children from one class to another on a
 case-by-case basis and through involvement of the Assistant Principal Pastoral
 Care and in consultation with both the Primary School and the High School
 Coordinators. In extreme circumstances, the matter should be brought to the Principal.
- No other placement of students from one class to another is allowed without involvement of the Assistant Principal – Pastoral Care.

Policy for Parents / Guardians:

 Parents / guardians are not allowed to request placement of their child / children from one class to another unless there are extenuating circumstances. In this instance, student placement requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis and through involvement of the Assistant Principal – Pastoral Care and the Primary School and High School Coordinators. No other placement of students from one class to another is allowed without involvement of the Assistant Principal – Pastoral Care and the Primary and High School Coordinators.
